

## 2015 Champion Heads Field

Another strong field is expected to contend for the three-day 2017 City Girls Junior Golf Championship that begins Monday (July 10) with the 18-holes girls playing at Shady Valley Country Club and the 9-hole girls at Sycamore Creek G.C.



Among the competitors is 2015 champion Trinity King, 15, (pictured). The Arlington Martin student won the title when she was 13 and finished third last year behind champion Kennedy Pedigo and Kim Kyong. They are not returning this year. King also has been honorable mention in the All-State 6A selections the past two years (2016-17) and has competed in the 2016 Nature Valley First Tee Open and the 2017 USGA Women's Four Ball since last year.

Others who made the Championship Flight 12-person cut last year and are returning include Aysis Azarcon, Caitlyn Lindell, Quinn Barber, Malisone Chanthapanya, Michelle Zhou and Karen Lee.

Azarcon, 15, and who attends Mansfield Timberview was fourth last year; Lindell, 17, and who attends Mansfield High School, was sixth last year; Barber, 17, and who attends Colleyville Heritage, was ninth; Zhou, 15, and who attends Carroll High School, was 11th and Lee, 16, who attends Southlake High School, was 12th.

Others include Jacqueline Moreno, 17. The Arlington Martin student won the First Flight last year. She was selected first team All District, and her high school team qualified for the 6A Regionals, where they finished fourth. Also, Stephanie Lee, 15, runner-up in the Second Flight last year is returning. She attends Southlake HS. Twin sisters Ashley and Madeline Davis, 16, finished third and fourth in the Second Flight last year and the Northwest HS students are returning.

Also, JJ Betz, 13, and who finished second behind sister Jax last year in the 9-hole Championship Flight, will be trying her hand in the 18-hole division. The Indian Springs Middle School has been placing high in Hurricane Junior Tour and WTJCT events.

Others who should be watched include Katie Jones, 17, Brooke Sullivan, 17, and Felicity Reeves, 17. Sullivan is a two-time Golfer of the Year at L.D. Bell High School, a two-time regional qualifier and has committed to play golf at Texas Wesleyan. Jones has won the 2016-2017 Region 2 District 9-5A championships while playing for Joshua High School. Reeves is the captain of the Chisholm Trail High School girls golf team, earned the most improved player award and was third in the First Tee of Fort Worth Championship Tournament.

After Shady Valley, the Division I girls will play Ridglea Country Club's Family Course and finish Wednesday at Mansfield National.
